Schedule

Saturday, September 12

1000-1030 Meet in the Santa Barbara Harbor parking lot at the east end (next to the launch ramps) to review plans. Please have your mast up and kite rigged.

1030-1130 Morning briefing. Land drills to walk through boat handling mechanics.

1130-1230 Bring your own lunch, or bring lunch money.

1230-1630 Drills on the water. Day 1 focus on boat handling, and first beat execution.

Sunday, September 13

0900-0930 Rig in the Santa Barbara Harbor parking lot at the east end (next to the launch ramps).

0930-1230 Light air boat handling drills on the water.

1230-1330 Bring your own lunch, or bring lunch money.

1330-1630 Afternoon racing drills on the water.

Parking

Parking is restricted to certain areas. The map included here shows where you can park your trailers, boats, and cars. If your car is in a trailer spot without a trailer attached, the parking enforcement people are likely to ticket you, so once you have unloaded, please make sure that your car makes it into a car stall.



Please keep the roadways clear as other launch ramp visitors and the harbor patrol may be coming through at several points. Additionally, please only launch using the middle and east most ramp. We will be leaving our boats next to the trailers on Saturday night.
